TRUST/TRUST-S*

Formerly the TIC-OSAT, the Trauma Responsive Understanding Self-Assessment Tool (TRUST) is a free online self-assessment tool that allows organizations to assess their progress in implementing practice change initiatives. A version specific for schools and educational settings, the Trauma Responsive Understanding Self-assessment Tool for Schools (TRUST-S) was developed and launched in 2019. These assessments are aligned with SAMHSA's principles of trauma-informed care and allow users to review individualized reports and recommendations.
