Example: Math, Chapter 5, Percentages

We can write a percent as a fraction if we put it over a fraction bar and 100.

- 1. Opening Ceremony:** Marks the beginning of the Circle by allowing participants to fully center themselves and be present.

**Round 5: Check out Round-**Fist of Five: How do you feel now after reviewing this topic together?
